RULES

Any discrepancies or conflicts will be left to the discretion of the judges. Poor sportsmanship and furious anger will not be tolerated.

1. Rope - 19	10. Roundhouse = 24
2. Aces round - 10	11. Roundhouse and rope = 43
3. Kings round = 8	12. Double pinochle = 30
4. Queens round = 6	13. Double rope = 150
5. Jacks round = 4	14. Eight aces = 100
6. Pinochle = 4	15. Eight kings = 80
7. Marriage in trump = 4	16. Eight queens = 60
8. Marriage = 2	17. Eight jacks = 40
9. Nine in trump = 1	

A total of 18 rounds will be played. Each round consists of 4 hands. Team number and player's names will be on the top of each score sheet. Teams will keep their own score in the left column, with opponent's score in the right column. At the completion of each round, teams will initial each other's score sheet, and bring them to the judges.

Dealing

- Cards must be dealt three at a time
- Dealer must offer deck to be cut.
- Each player deals once in each round.
- Request a new deck if cards are worn or marked.

Bidding

- Bid opens at 30
- A drop bid on the dealer is 25. All hands MUST be played.
- No jump bidding is allowed. Any form of signalling will result in disqualification from the tournament.

Sets (25 cent single set, 50 cent double set - each player)

- If you bid your hand and go set, you must play the hand but pay .50 cents each or \$1.00 total for set.
- If the bid is dropped on you and you go set, you will pay .25 cents each or .50 cents total for the set.
- All sets are to be paid at the completion of each round.

Play of hand

- Bidder and partner must pass 3 cards to each other. The bidder has the option to request a "no pass".
- All hands MUST be played.
- Opponents need to take a trick to keep their meld.
- Player must kill down.
- Player must play trump if they are out of a suit that is led.
- A card is considered played when the trick is turned over.

Renège

- Renège by bidding team - Opposing team will keep their meld, and 25 trick points. Bidder will pay a .50 cents double set and go back in their bid.
- Renège by non-bidding team - The player will lose their meld, and receive zero trick points. The player will pay a .25 cents for set fee. The bidding team will keep their meld plus 25 trick points.
- Renège will NOT be called for accidentally laying down too many cards for meld, or dropping cards.
