



2022 Monthly Offerings vs Budget



Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

It seems that we are only barely finished with Christmas. However, in the month of February we will begin the season of Lent with Ash Wednesday on February 22nd. This year's Lenten theme will be "Seeking". I think the series description says it best:

"The season's scriptures offer us many stories of Jesus encountering people who are seeking: Nicodemus comes to him in the veil of night, he approaches a Samaritan woman at a well, he heals a man born without sight. In these stories, each person is seeking a new beginning, a different life, a deeper faith. What unfolds is an exchange filled with questions and exploration. Often, an unveiling occurs—assumptions are disrupted, and we hope new perspective is revealed.

Like the characters in our Lenten scriptures, we are also seeking many things: clarity, connection, wonder, justice, balance. We are seeking our calling and how to live as disciples. Throughout the turbulence of the past few years, many of us are asking big questions about our lives and our faith. We hope this series will help us think about some of those big questions in ways that are honest and faithful. Throughout this season, we hope you will continually ask yourself: what am I seeking? What is God seeking?

This Lent, we invite you to engage in the spiritual practice of seeking. We encourage you to stay curious, open, and nimble. We hope you will soften your assumptions and expand your perspectives. We pray that these questions will create a safe space to explore—to be drawn more deeply into the fullness of life, into the heart of God."

Come seeking this Lent. Come and see how our opinions and certainties can be changed with the words of Jesus. Come and find what you are looking for.
