

### **IMPORTANT THINGS TO KNOW**


- \*Communion 4th, 18th and 24th this month- no communion Jan. 1.

## A Note from the Treasurer


Below is a chart of monthly offerings for 2019 – October 2022. It includes Sunday offerings plus Lent services and Christmas Eve. This chart does not include special gifts, memorials, or other income.

Historically March/April (Lent & Easter) and December have the highest monthly offerings. May – September are lower offering months. As of the end of October, Hope Lutheran in \$1,000 below budget for offerings. We are close to meeting the offering budget for the first time since I have been treasurer – THANK YOU.

BUT.... The congregation's budget is dependent on extra offerings and gifts in December. There are many ways to make tax friendly donations. Hope Lutheran received its first Gift of Grain in October. In 2019, the shortfall in offerings was covered by transferring a \$10,000 CD to the General Fund Checking Account. In 2020 and 2021, Hope Lutheran received PPP Grants totaling \$30,525. Also, in July 2021 Hope Lutheran entered into a Ministry Covenant with the Florence Parish. Their contribution has helped our budget greatly.



As we approach the Christmas season, I see a lot of signs for "Keep Christ in Christmas". Which are good. But, I do find the argument against the use of "Xmas" interesting. People feel that taking the word "Christ" out of Christmas and replacing it with an "X" makes it less about Jesus and more about the worldly consumer attitude. I came across a writing about this I wanted to share with you. It is from a writer named Brian Stoffregen. (He is a pastor and a text study specialist who many of us turn to for help with our sermons.)


"There are often complaints about the word "Xmas". "They've taken Christ out of Christmas," decry some.

Christ may have been replaced by commercialism in the celebration of this Festival season, but that isn't where the "X" comes from.

The word "Christ" in Greek looks like this: ΧΡΙΣΤΟΣ (pronounced "christos"). The first letter is an "X," but it isn't an "ex" as in our alphabet, but a "chi" (rhymes with "sky") in the Greek alphabet. This letter has a "ch" sound – like in the word "Christ".

While the second letter looks like a P (pee), in Greek it is a Rho and sounds like the English "R". The "chi rho" is common Christian symbol that uses the first two letters from  $XPI\Sigma TO\Sigma$ . Because of the shape of the letters, the symbol is often mistaken for a "PX". A chi-rho symbol is one of the oldest Christian symbols. Some examples of the Chi-Rho symbols are attached. There's probably one in your congregation.

Spelling the holiday "Xmas" doesn't necessarily take Christ out of the holiday; neither does spelling the word "Christmas" put Christ into the holiday."



You may have seen these signs around the church.

They are all from the Greek language, the original language the New Testament was written in, and mean the name of Christ. So, the next time you see "Xmas" don't cringe. Just smile and know that there is nothing that the world can do to remove our Savior from the celebration of his birth. Commercialism, business, greed, political correctness or anything the world can throw at it does not matter. Christ the Savior was born! That makes all the difference!
