The Town Board met in regular session on July 6th, 2026 at 7:00 p.m. at the firehall. President Travis Benthin present, members Dale Bauer & Frank Redlin present. Others present were: Norma Arend-finance officer, Jim Thurman, Josh Neuhard, David Cardwell, Kathy Quale, Nick VanElsacker, Calvin & Becky Pies, Mike Tunnissen, Savannah Moe, Connie Brotzel and Tim Gapp & Andrew Carrell.

Benthin called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Public communications: Mike Tunnessin informed the board his last day at Tuny's Bar will be July 11th. The bar is closing. The park bathrooms will be closed due to vandalism issues. Contact Jim Thurman if you need him to open them for an event. Andrew Carrell complained about the brush pile on city property near his property. The city will clean it up.

Motion by Benthin, second by Redlin to approve the minutes, financial reports and claims as presented. Motion carried. ***Insert Claims**

The water meters are in. Contact Jim Thurman if you want the city to install yours. There will not be an installation cost to the resident.
