Are you ready? Being ready for things is a goal of mine. I tend to carry way too much of, "what if this happens and I need something line______" fill in the blank with everything from medication and bandages to flashlights and safety pins. In CPE (Clinical Pastoral Education Class), I learned that this urge to be ready probably comes from a childhood full of loss and trauma. We lost our house to a fire, my brother died, our business burned, we moved away from home and friends.... These and many other things happened in a few of my very formative years.

So, when someone asks me, "Are you ready?" They better be prepared for the many things I am ready for.

In the season of Advent, which begins Dec. 3rd, we are asked to make ourselves ready. Traditionally Advent was about readying ourselves for the return of Jesus Christ. Most often, in today's world, it becomes about readying ourselves for Christmas. I think this year, we can do both.

The hymn, Joy to The World, has a verse that says, "Let every heart, prepare him room". I think that's a great place to start your Advent and Christmas season. Unclogging your heart and mind with the extra craziness that comes this time of year. Dusting out our old ignored corners and opening our whole selves for not just the birth but also the return of our Savior. It's not, "Jesus is coming, look busy" instead it's, "Jesus is coming, open and prepare your heart, your mind and your soul."

But that can be HARD! There are the normal culprits that take our attention: decorating, money worries as we shop, the time crunch of baking or attending concerts or hosting people over or whatever it is that keeps you from preparing your heart.

This year's Advent theme helps us prepare our hearts in a special way. This year we will hear how to, "Rejoice in a weary world". We will learn to prepare our hearts in spite of war, worry, pain, busyness, loneliness, and all the other things that plague us today.

I offer you this prayer from our upcoming service to begin your Advent.

Holy God, we know that you are near. We know that you are standing at the door, you are running down the driveway, you are inviting us in—into your Word, into relationship, and deeper into joy. So, as we approach your Word, O God, we pray: do not let us pass you by. Do not allow distraction or doubt to get the best of us. Do not let us walk down this Advent road without you. Instead, give us the wisdom to turn and run your way. Give us the wisdom to hear your wisdom, to let it sink into our bones and change us. With hope and gratitude, we pray, amen.
